### Key Actions: How might we get there?

#### Term 1-4

**ACTION**

Implement the site's Reconciliation Action Plan

**HOW**

- All staff to undertake Cultural Awareness training in 2026
- School Acknowledgement of Country video published on website in 2026
- Aboriginal Perspectives, histories and cultures to be incorporated into curriculum to advance reconciliation across the site

#### Term 1-4

**ACTION**

Create opportunities for our community to develop a strong sense of belonging and connection to the school.

**HOW**

- Host termly parent workshops at the school that support student learning and wellbeing
- Consult with students, staff and community on new school uniform designs for 2027
- Expand our extra-curricular activity pathways and programs for students at school
- Embed cross-age buddy systems across the school

#### Term 1 - 4

**ACTION**

Strengthen communication processes between school and families.

**HOW**

- Governing Council to develop survey tool for parent and community feedback
- Student assessment & wellbeing information to be shared with families more readily

### Progress Indicators

- Staff report greater confidence in incorporating Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander perspectives in their planning and delivery through Term 1 and Term 4 pulse check survey tool
- Increase in high wellbeing measures as reported through the 'Engagement with School' domain collected through WEC survey Term 2 results.
- Increase in school parent engagement survey measures for 'Learning at School' & 'Learning at Home' domains
